



Missouri Available Project Background...

- Project is sponsored by Broadband Stimulus Funding through the federal government...
- Federal share = \$869,067 \$217,000 to the RPCs
- RPC cost shares = \$7,500 (in-kind)
- Total funding = \$1,009,067
- Four previous project iterations SEMO/Bootheel 2007-2008
 Boonslick 2008-2009) funded by FGDC/USGS Cooperative Agreement Program (CAP) funding...
 Mid-MO RPC 2001-2011

What we're trying to accomplish...

- Data sharing partnerships designed to be maintained and current across Missouri's landscape...
- Enhanced regional working relationships promoting geospatial decision support for emergency events and plan
- To prove the premise to state and federal entities that local government data is the not only usually the most accurate but the most timely and can best be maintained locally.


Methodology

- Regionalized local review
 - Parallel roles Community Anchor Points for Broadband analysis, transportation plans, homeland security plans, economic development plans, etc. (multipurpose)
 - Targeted layers and attributes derived from local review and EOC input (maintenance)
 - Incentives data, standards, tools, and \$
 - Built on existing relationships and data development partnering from prior FGDC CAP and USGS Partnership grants




