- Regular monthly meetings provide a forum for discussion among primary and secondary stakeholders including: Missouri Spatial Data Information Service, Office of Geospatial Information, State commissions, State agencies, local county and municipal governments, regional planning organizations, educational organizations, federal agencies.
- Coordinates aerial imagery and LiDAR data development projects, funding, and distribution of deliverables across federal agencies, state departments, regional groups, and local governments.
- Champions the appropriate use of geospatial technology throughout the state for users at all scales, types of organizations, and age levels.
- Organizes the Missouri GIS Conference in odd-number years. More than seven conferences have brought together stakeholders and users from across the state to discuss and explore emerging geospatial technologies and technical applications.
- Supports emergency management, homeland security, and public safety planning, preparation, and response efforts.
- Supports the Esri K-12 Statewide License, regional outreach workshops, and training in GIS, geospatial technologies, and the United States National Grid.
- Furthers the understanding of the status of GIS implementation across the Missouri.
- Provides oversight and guidance for the Missouri Spatial Data Information Service, dating from their mutual establishment in 1996.
